# Award-winning WWII game from perspective of survivors released on Steam

Attentat 1942 has already taken home several international awards and is currently a finalist in the Game Development World Championship 2017.

October 31, 2017 (Prague, Czech Republic) -- Attentat 1942, a historically-accurate video game about the assassination of Reinhard Heydrich, ruler of the Nazi-occupied Czech Lands, is now available on Steam.

"The civilian perspective is typically missing in war-themed games," says Vít Šisler, the game's lead designer. "Attentat 1942 shows the profound impact the war and the totalitarian regime had on the lives and minds of ordinary people. It immerses players in living histories of personal tragedy and pain, but also extraordinary hope and courage."

Based on research conducted by professional historians and documented testimonies, Attentat 1942 explores WWII through the eyes of its surviving civilians. Combining interactive comics, video-interviews, and archival film footage, the game presents a unique depiction of the recent past. "This game offers a stark reminder of the dangers of fascism and political radicalism," says Shawn Clybor, the game's content localization and translation advisor.

Attentat 1942 is a significantly enhanced, translated version of the game Československo 38–89: Atentát, which was released in Czech Republic, and won the "Best Debut" category of the Czech Game of the Year Awards in 2015. Attentat 1942 has been developed by Charles University and the Czech Academy of Sciences, and was supported by the Czech Ministry of Culture and the Technology Agency of the Czech Republic.
